Candidate Selection Criteria:

To be eligible for this award, candidates must meet the following requirements:

- Be enrolled full-time in any diploma or degree program related to the Petroleum Industry, but not necessarily restricted to an Engineering program
- Be an active student member of the SPE
- Satisfactory academic standing
- Demonstrate financial need
- Extra-curricular activities through SPE, university and community
- Canadian citizen or landed immigrant status

Application Requirements:

- University/college transcripts (photocopy of original transcript is acceptable)
 - A cover letter discussing (point format preferred):
 - Your circumstances for financial need. If applicable, include supporting documentation, scholarships/bursaries received to date, outstanding student loan amounts, expected date of graduation, employment, etc.
 - Involvement in SPE with the Canadian Section and the Student Chapter. Include SPE volunteer positions and participation in SPE related activities
 - Extra-curricular and community related activities. Include volunteer positions/organizations, community/city clubs, etc. Greater emphasis will be placed on SPE related participation
 - Include your SPE student membership number, email, mailing address and SIN for tax purposes on your letter
 - Any other information the applicant considers relevant to the decision of the selection committee
 - An updated copy of your résumé
- All information provided will be treated in strict confidentiality by the SPE selection committee
- Only successful applicants will be notified by SPE
